Following Maya’s birth in 1995, Sigal devoted herself fully to her family and home, embracing motherhood with love and dedication.

In addition to her unwavering commitment to her family, Sigal gave generously of her time to numerous causes. She was an active volunteer with Beit Halochem, Zera Café, and CHW, and played a meaningful role in the Montreal Jewish community and at the Montreal Torah Centre.
